**Program Description**

The Mid-South Sociological Association and the Committee on Minorities is pleased to announce the availability of travel scholarships for support in attending the 2018 annual meeting in Birmingham, Alabama. These scholarships will be awarded on a competitive basis. Each scholarship recipient will be offered up to \$250 to defray expenses associated with travel to the MSSA meeting.

**Eligibility and Application Requirements**

To be eligible for the scholarship, the applicant must be:

- A faculty member from a Historically Black College or University (HBCU), Hispanic Serving Institution (HSI), Tribal College or University (TCU), or Native American serving, non-tribal institution; **or** a faculty member that identifies as a member of an ethnic or racial minority group that is currently employed at any college or university located in the Mid-South region.
- An active participant of the 2018 annual meeting: presenting a paper, poster, or participating in an invited panel (*Paper and poster submissions due September 1<sup>st</sup>*)
- A member of the Mid-South Sociological Association at the time of the award.
