Program Description

The Mid-South Sociological Association and the Committee on Minorities is pleased to announce the availability of travel scholarships for support in attending the 2020 annual meeting in Nashville, Tennessee (October 14-17). These scholarships will be awarded on a competitive basis. Each scholarship recipient will be offered up to \$250 to defray expenses associated with travel to the MSSA meeting.

Eligibility and Application Requirements

To be eligible for the scholarship, the applicant must be:

- A faculty member, graduate student, or undergraduate student from/attending a Historically Black College or University (HBCU), Hispanic Serving Institution (HSI), Tribal College or University (TCU), or Native American serving, non-tribal institution; **or** a faculty member or graduate student that identifies as a member of an ethnic or racial minority group that is currently employed at any college or university located in the Mid-South region.
- An active participant of the annual meeting: presenting a paper, poster, or participating in an invited panel
- A member of the Mid-South Sociological Association at the time of the award.
